How many are your neighbors in Greater Nashua?

Some people experiencing homelessness find temporary shelter with friends or family. Some sleep in their cars. Some have no choice but to sleep outside. **On Saturday, April 21**, Nashua North High School in Nashua will be home to the **5th Annual Box City**, a one-night event to raise money and awareness for Anne-Marie House (AMH). AMH supports children and families experiencing homelessness by providing temporary housing, wholesome meals, transportation and life skills programs.

SERVICE & YOUTH GROUPS

Box City is a youth-focused event open to 6th-12th graders. We encourage service clubs, school groups, boy scout/girl scout troops, faith-based youth groups and other youth organizations to use this event as a learning opportunity. Participants sleep in a box home in a safe and secure outdoor area. A minimum of one adult chaperone per five youth under 18 is required. Each group is asked to provide their own chaperones for the event.

****Please note this year that participants are required to bring their own cardboard boxes to build with, as well as any other sleep out gear.**

HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. Register for Box City by filling out the registration form in this brochure, enclose your **registration fee of \$15 per person** and return to: **AMH, Attn: Box City, 180 Lowell Road, Hudson, NH 03051**. You may also register on the day of the event at **\$20 per person**.
2. Upon registering, you will be emailed an information packet about the event, which includes a pledge form and instructions for picking up your "House for Change" — two tools to help you start your fundraising!
3. Collect pledges for AMH using the pledge form and "House for Change" collection box. Ask friends and family to support you and AMH with a donation. Every dollar makes a difference!
4. **Come to Nashua North High School, 10 Chuck Druding Dr., Nashua on Saturday** on April 21, build your box home, participate in meaningful educational activities about homelessness and sleep overnight outside. Box City is held rain, shine, or even snow!
