## **Find Some Friends**

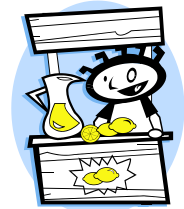

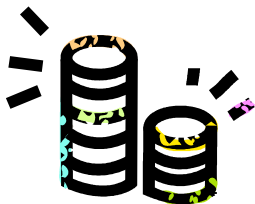
## **Have a Lemonade Stand or Bake Sale**
